General Safety.

6. Never eat or drink in the lab.
7. Stay at your lab station during class unless you are getting materials.

Dress Code

First Aid

1. Report accidents immediately to your teacher.
2. If you spill chemicals on your skin, rinse with water for 20 minutes. Use the eyewash or chemical shower as appropriate.

Heating and Fire Safety

1. Do not heat any chemicals or any other materials unless instructed.
2. Use the fire blanket or extinguisher for any fires.

Chemical Safety

1. Only mix approved chemicals.
2. Do not touch, taste or smell or extinguish any fires unless given permission.
